

PACKING LIST



This list should be used as a guideline while packing. Please do not feel pressure to purchase anything new as camp is a great place to wear out old clothes! MOST importantly, please make sure E.V.E.R.Y.T.H.I.N.G is labelled with camper's first initial and last name (ex: K. Nelson). Everything needs to fit into two, soft-sided duffel bags. A sleeping bag & change of clothing need to fit into a carry-on that can be carried by campers when traveling home.

CLOTHING

- 8-10 t-shirts (including a tribe t-shirt)
- 4 long-sleeved shirts/sweatshirts
- 5 pairs of shorts
- 5 pairs of comfortable pants
- 12 pairs of underwear
- 5 bras/sports bras/undershirts
- 12 pairs of cotton socks
- 2 pair of wool socks (optional)
- 2-3 swimsuits
- 2 warm sets of PJs
- 1 bathrobe or shower cover-up
- 1 rain jacket
- 1 warm jacket (fleece is a good option)
- 1 white shirt for special programs
- 1 white shirt that can be stained with colored dye or mud!

TOILETRIES

- Toothbrush, toothbrush case, toothpaste
- Soap (and soap container) or body wash
- Loofah/wash cloth (2)
- Shampoo/conditioner/haircare products
- Face wipes or face wash
- Hairbrush/comb
- Hair elastics/headbands (if applicable)
- Nail clippers/nail file
- Deodorant/antiperspirant (if applicable)
- Body lotion
- Chapstick with sun protection (essential)
- Sunscreen (essential)
- Insect repellent (essential)
- After Bite
- Hand Sanitizer and/or sanitizing wipes
- Tissues
- Sanitary pads/tampons (NO plastic applicators)
- Shaving toiletries (optional)
- 1 shower caddy/bucket (to carry toiletries)
- 2 pairs contact lenses/eyeglasses (ESSENTIAL if applicable)
- Saline/Contact Solution (if applicable)
- Eyeglass/sunglass lanyard that holds glasses on while participating in waterfront activities.
- Medications (All must be registered thru PackMyRx : see Health: Medication PackMyRx in CampinTouch account to register ASAP)

New campers will be gifted a Kamaji shirt in their tribe color.

SHOES

- 2 pairs sneakers/tennis shoes/running shoes
- 1 pair of sturdy water shoes that secure to ankle to be worn while participating in waterfront activities (essential)
- 1 pair of shower shoes (can be flip-flops but only used in shower)
- 1 pair rubber rain boots
- 1 pair riding boots with a heel (optional: can use rainboots!)
- 1 pair hiking boots (optional: rising 5th graders for hiking trip)

LINENS

- 2 warm blankets
- 2 sets of cot/twin sized sheets (30"-36" wide)
- 2 pillowcases
- 3 bath/shower towels
- 3 beach towels
- 2 hand/face towels
- 1 large laundry bag
- 5 mesh delicates laundry bags (for underwear, socks, and bras/suits)
- 1 pillow

CAMPING EQUIPMENT

- Inexpensive sleeping bag with stuff sack
- Flashlight/lantern and/or headlamp & extra batteries
- Hat with a visor for sun protection
- Insulated water bottle (essential)
- Camping chair (such as a "Crazy Creek"-generic ones work just as great)
- Inexpensive sunglasses

EXTRAS/OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Special sleep item/stuffed animal/blanket/lovey
- Books, journal, playing cards, games, fidget items
- Stationery, envelopes, stamps, and pens (a list of addresses for camper to address outgoing mail)
- Fun items/clothes in your tribe color (new campers will receive a pkg during session)
- CDs of your favorite music
- Inexpensive, battery-operated camera
- Tennis Racket
- Swim Goggles
- Swim Shirt/Wet Suit Shirt/Rash Guard
- Bandana
- Pictures, posters, tape/removable command strips, decorations for cabin (no push pins please & no writing on cabin/building is permitted)
- Clipboard
- Embroidery floss for friendship bracelets
- Plastic, sturdy boxes with lids to hold stationery, stamps, envelopes, pens, tape
- Dress-up costumes, **tutus**, face paint, nail polish, boas (please NO feather boas)
- Onesie (as a costume, pjs or whatever!)
