

We are revamping our LT program in the hopes of making it more fun and enticing for our girls! Come for 1 session or both!

More time with friends plus foundations and building blocks for independence, confidence and responsibility at camp but perhaps most importantly, for their lives away from camp.

Opportunities to participate in Kamaji's Life Lessons courses. LTs will have lessons in how to do laundry without turning the whole load pink, cook a delicious meal, and even change a tire.

Ability to earn a Certification Bonus.

A job offer for summer 2025. Counselors who have participated in and completed the Leadership Training Program start at a higher salary than those who have not completed the Training Program. Those counselors who have volunteered as LTs are also offered their top choices for activity preferences when they return.

FIRST SESSION PERKS

An extended camper program with opportunities presented for participants to practice skills needed to be a strong leader.

LTs will live together for the session in a cabin.
The LT Counselor will live in thesame cabin to
provide support and guidance.

This is a unique experience that will challenge and enhance your communication skills, empathy, ability to compromise, and give you the opportunity to connect with campers in a traditional counselor role while being guided by senior counselors.

LTs will gain valuable teaching skills and grow their own knowledge by co-instructing an activity with a senior staff member for 3 periods each day and 1 activity period left for "me time"...

Time-off including one sleep-in morning, one afternoon out of camp, and one night off in camp each week. Engaging activities are pre-planned by our program team to ensure the LTs have an impactful and fun summer.

Some of the offered time off activities may include visiting another camp, campfires with tin foil dinners and s'mores, attending the local carnival, bowling, movie night at the theater, and of course a chance to check out the shops and restaurants in the area.
