





# Content created just for **YOU**, the parent!!

I have been doing “the camp thing” for a long time. I’ve worked year-round recruiting campers for 22 years- Gah! Truth is, it has always been easy for me to talk about Kamaji, I love it. When I first started working as the Associate Director, I was freshly out of college, single, excited to buy my first queen bed and move into my new apartment in a new city. Needless to say, things feel a teeny bit different now. I am in my mid-40's, freshly into perimenopause, I’ve been married for 13 years, we have 3 children who are real humans and I’m complaining about how our mattress does not support my sore back in a house with a mortgage! Teeny bit different.

You can imagine that my perspective on camp changed a bit from when I first started recruiting to now, as a mom. I know how wonderful camp is for kids. And, I know how hard it is for me to let them go to camp, to be away from me, to experience hard feelings like missing home, missing me, maybe even feeling sad at times. And- thankfully, I also know firsthand, about how important sleepaway camp is as a foundation. Whenever I miss my children or worry about them, I think about how this is preparing them for their futures, making them stronger, smarter and more capable.

I recently made a little Instagram vid talking about the investment we, as parents, make in camp. Since not everyone is on the Instagram (and if you are, please follow @campakamaji for incredible content), I thought I’d share my thoughts here...y’know, for my avid “Parents’ Block” fans...

For many families, camp is an emotional investment. You’re trusting a place and a community with a very important part of her life.

And yes — it’s also a financial investment.

But here’s the thing most families realize after a few summers at Camp Kamaji:  
Camp only feels expensive when we compare it to the wrong things.

Every year — and for some families, every season — we invest in our kids’ activities.

Sports leagues.

Club teams.

Private coaching.

Dance classes.

Costumes and competitions.

Travel tournaments.

Music lessons.

Tutors.



We invest thousands in helping our kids grow in athletics, academics, and interests — and we call those investments opportunities. We rarely pause before signing up.

But when it comes to a month at camp — living away from home, building independence, navigating friendships, leading, trying new things, learning who you are — it can sometimes feel like a bigger, different type of decision.

What if camp is actually the highest-return investment you'll ever make in your daughter?

At Kamaji, your daughter isn't just practicing a skill for a few hours a week. She's practicing being herself. She is doing this in a supportive community where girls are learning, growing, laughing, and figuring things out together. She practices resilience. She practices navigating friendship without a group text. She practices confidence without you standing next to her. And she does it every single day for 26 days.



Think about it this way.  
A season of sports builds athletic skill.  
A tutor builds academic knowledge.  
And the time away at camp builds something different — and arguably more lasting.

It builds the ability to walk into a new room without you.  
To solve a problem with a friend.  
To try something hard and keep going.  
To trust herself.  
That month away helps develop independence, emotional intelligence, decision-making, leadership, and self-confidence — the skills that quietly shape how a young woman moves through the world.

And those skills compound for decades.

As parents, we often say we want daughters who are confident.  
Who advocate for themselves.  
Who stand tall in new situations.  
But confidence isn't taught in a one-hour lesson.  
It's built through experience.  
At Kamaji, girls see confidence modeled around them.  
They practice it; They grow into it;  
And then they carry it home with them.



Camp shouldn't be a luxury.  
It's not childcare.  
It's not just summer fun.  
It is a thoughtful, strategic investment in who she is becoming.

And the truth many families discover is this:  
The girls who come back year after year don't just love camp more each summer — they grow in ways that are hard to replicate anywhere else.  
If your daughter has already experienced Kamaji, you've seen glimpses of this growth. Imagine what another summer — another 26 days of independence, friendship, challenge, and joy — could build next. It's exciting.

Sometimes the most meaningful investments we make are the ones that shape who our children become long after the summer ends.


